OSCEOLA WATER BOARD May 12, 2016

The Osceola Water Board met for the rescheduled meeting on Thursday, May 12, 2016 at 5:30 P.M. This being the time and place as legally posted, the meeting was called to order by Vice - Chairman Larry Bishop with the following Board Members present: Laura Castro, Mark Binning and MacKenzie O'Hair. Board member Kale was absent. Also present were Superintendent Brandon Patterson, Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda, Administrative Assistant Kim Allard, Water Distribution Foreman Dallas Blair and others not signed in.

Board member O'Hair motioned to approve the agenda as presented and Binning seconded the motion.

Water Superintendent Brandon Patterson opened the discussion regarding the FY 2016-2017 employee pay proposals by stating the employee evaluations have been completed and presented a listing of each employee, their license grade levels and an average pay scale from other communities for each job title for board consideration. After discussion, board member Binning motioned to approve the FY 2016-2017 employee pay proposals as presented and Castro seconded the motion. The approved pay proposal includes a 2% pay increase effective July 1, 2016 for the following positons; Distribution Foreman, Office Manager, Administrative Assistant and Plant Operators. The board also approved setting pay for the Distribution Technician/Plant Operator at \$19.50/hour, Maintenance Operator II/GIS Specialist at \$20.50/hour and Maintenance Operator I at the rate of \$20.50/hour upon completion of obtaining a grade 1 water license and successful completion of the one year probationary period.
