## OSCEOLA WATER BOARD February 13, 2019

The Osceola Water Board met for the rescheduled meeting on Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. This being the time and place as legally posted, the meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Larry Bishop with the following Board Members present: MacKenzie O'Hair, Mark Binning and Jim Kimball. Board member Alisha Kale was absent. Also present were Superintendent Brandon Patterson, Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda, Bob Johnson, Mary Johnson and others not signed in.

Board member O'Hair motioned to approve the agenda as presented and Binning seconded the motion.

Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda opened the discussion regarding the water portion of the utility bill for the Osceola Senior Center by introducing Robert Johnson and presenting information received from the center regarding budget, banking and meals served. Also presented was the utility bills from the last year for the board to review. Board member Kimball inquired regarding the center raising money to cover the center's expenses. After discussion, board member Binning motioned to approve a donation for the water portion of the utility billing for 2019 and O'Hair seconded the motion. Roll call of the vote was:

Board member Kimball opened the discussion regarding the water rates for the Osceola Greens by presenting the city will own the Osceola Country Club and would like the board to have discussion regarding the "greens" utility bill at water production cost. After discussion, the board agreed to table the discussion to the March board meeting in order to get more information and clarification.

Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda opened the discussion regarding the insurance coverage at the Water Treatment Plant by stating that an insurance review was completed and the cost of the water treatment plant was in question. Engineer Mark Duben gave an estimated cost for replacement of the Water Treatment Plant to be in the area of \$14 million an increase from the current \$8.9 million covered today. After discussion, the board agreed to table the topic until the March meeting to get additional information.

Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda opened the discussion regarding the contract and performance and/or payment bonds for Maguire Iron, Inc. for the downtown water tower project. Presented to the board were a resolution authorizing the board's approval for agreement, performance bond, payment bond maintenance bond and certificate of insurance documentation. The board needed to pass the resolution to formally approve the contract documents. After discussion, board member Binning motioned to approve the documents as presented and Kimball seconded the motion. Roll call of the vote was;

Water Superintendent Report: Brandon Patterson reported to the board four main breaks that were repaired by Water Works staff. Mr. Patterson continued by giving an update on items needing attention at the water treatment plant and anticipated expenses. Mr. Patterson completed his report by giving the lake level and an update on the CCRC.

Vice Chairman Bishop presented the consent agenda. Board member Kimball motioned to approve the consent agenda as presented and Binning seconded the motion.
