## OSCEOLA WATER BOARD April 4, 2019

The Osceola Water Board met for the regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. This being the time and place as legally posted, the meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Larry Bishop with the following Board Members present: MacKenzie O'Hair, Mark Binning and Jim Kimball.
