OSCEOLA WATER BOARD December 3, 2020

The Osceola Water Board met for the regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, December 3, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. This being the time and place as legally posted, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Alisha Kale with the following Board Members present: Larry Bishop, Mark Binning, Dr. Jim Kimball and Sara O'Hair. Also present were Superintendent Brandon Patterson, Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda, Water Works Foreman Royce Robertson and others not signed in.

Board member Kimball motioned to approve the agenda as presented and Binning seconded the motion.

Utility Office Manager Carrie Benda opened the discussion regarding penalty waiver request for Friendly Acres Mobile Home Park by stating that Friendly Acres Trailer Park contacted us regarding a penalty that they received and requested a waiver. Mrs. Benda continued by stating that after review of the account, it appears that the utility account would qualify for a waiver of \$207.70 as per the rules and regulations. After discussion, board member Kimball motioned to issue the penalty waiver as per the rules and regulations and Bishop seconded the motion.

Mr. Patterson explained items that cause issues with balancing which includes the plant repairs, main breaks and chemicals treatment challenges. After discussion, a work session with all board members to go through figures and make changes was set for Wednesday, December 9, 2020 at 2:00 p.m.

Water Superintendent Report: Brandon Patterson shared with the board the upcoming holiday schedule, one water main repair that was completed, and plant repairs in process. Mr. Patterson continued by discussions regarding the budget and operator certification exams. Mr. Patterson completed his report by giving an update on the Clarke County Reservoir Commission.

Chairman Kale presented the consent agenda. Board member Bishop motioned to approve the consent agenda as presented and O'Hair seconded the motion.
